

RESOLUTION NO. 4821

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT FUNDS THROUGH THE OREGON EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AS PART OF THE FEMA FY02 SUPPLEMENTAL ALL HAZARD EMERGENCY OPERATION PLANNING GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING A HAZARD ANALYSIS OF THE CITY AND PROVIDING A RESPONSE AND RECOVERY PLAN TO TERRORIST ATTACKS AS PART OF THE CITY'S ALL HAZARD EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council at its March 3, 2003, meeting approved, by Resolution No. 4803, the Fire Department to apply for a grant through Oregon Emergency Management for the purpose of conducting a hazard analysis of the city and providing a response and recovery plan to terrorist attacks as part of the City's all hazard emergency response plan; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department applied for and has been notified of an award of \$31,196 for the purpose of conducting a hazard analysis of the city and providing a response and recovery plan to terrorist attacks as part of the City's all hazard emergency response plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City of Albany accepts the Oregon Emergency Management grant in the amount of \$31,196 for the purpose of conducting a hazard analysis of the city and providing a response and recovery plan to terrorist attacks as part of the City's all hazard emergency response plan and authorizes the City Manager to execute the agreement and conditions for acceptance.
