

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE 2004 SAFETY BELT/THREE FLAGS TRAFFIC SAFETY GRANT FROM THE OREGON ASSOCIATION CHIEFS OF POLICE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,960.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police makes funds available for organizations that will provide focused traffic enforcement for DUII, safety belt, and speeding violations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany Police Department has been invited to apply for and receive these funds from the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police, CFDA #20.600; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of the grant funds will allow the Department to focus an additional 56 hours to traffic enforcement for DUII, safety belt, and speeding violations.

WHEREAS, acceptance of the grant funds will not require local matching funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council does hereby state that traffic safety, including speed, safety belt, and DUII enforcement, are priorities.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Albany City Council authorizes the Albany Police Department to apply for and accept this grant for \$1,960.
