

RESOLUTION NO. 5375

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MULTIPLE APPLICATIONS TO THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE 2007-2009 BIENNIUM DISCRETIONARY GRANTS FOR TRANSIT TO PURCHASE VEHICLES AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES AND TO CONTRACT WITH A TRANSIT PLANNER

WHEREAS, Albany Call-A-Ride, Albany Transit System, and the Linn-Benton Loop Transit System are qualified to provide public transportation ; and

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council is the governing body for the public transit systems.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council authorizes staff to apply to the Oregon Department of Transportation for biennial 2007-2009 discretionary grants as listed in Exhibit A to provide funding for vehicle purchase, preventive maintenance, operating monies, and transit planning; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Albany City Council authorizes the Economic Development Director to sign the applications on behalf of the City.

1. Matching funds for an established Title 19 grant.
2. Replacement of one 14 passenger modified bus, one accessible minivan, and preventive maintenance funding for all C-A-R vehicles.
3. Additional accessible minivan to meet expanded needs of senior citizens and disabled persons.
4. Funds to continue operating Saturdays and two city holidays as begun in the 06-07 FY.
5. Contract with a transit planner to help us design improvements to services in light of the growth Albany has experienced in recent years.
6. Funding to assist in maintaining our aging ATS buses.
7. Funding to establish Saturday and two city holidays service on the in-town buses.
8. Replace the two 30-year old passenger shelters at 2<sup>nd</sup> and Broadalbin.
9. Purchase one shelter for the senior and disabled housing units ("Ice House") when constructed at 3<sup>rd</sup> and Calapooia.
10. Funds to continue operating Saturdays and two city holidays as begun in the 06-07 FY.
11. Funds to expand Loop service to create a Lebanon-LBCC-Corvallis route system; requires #12 an additional bus.
12. Funds to purchase a new bus to allow #11, a Lebanon-LBCC-Corvallis route system.
13. Funding to assist in maintaining our aging Loop buses
