

A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING APPROPRIATION FOR THE RECENTLY APPROVED TRAINING LIEUTENANT POSITION

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has recognized a need to provide additional training and essential safety personnel at the scene of high-risk and major emergencies; and

WHEREAS, on September 26, 2007, the City Council approved reclassification of the Fire Department's Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Chief and Training Chief positions and established a new Training Lieutenant position; and

WHEREAS, existing appropriations are adequate to implement the changes to the EMS Chief and Training Chief positions, but a transfer of appropriation is needed for the new Training Lieutenant position; and

WHEREAS, Oregon Local Budget Law provides that a decrease of one existing appropriation and a corresponding increase of another existing appropriation may be made after enactment of a resolution or ordinance authorizing the transfer; and


WHEREAS, the resolution or ordinance must state the need for the transfer, the purpose of the expenditure, and the amount to be transferred (ORS 294.450(1)&(3)).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council as follows:


