



RESOLUTION NO. 6791

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FIRE AND LIFE SAFETY SERVICE FEES, AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 6558.

WHEREAS, the City Council reviews and authorizes service fees; and

WHEREAS, the City Council established and maintains a fee schedule for various Fire Department permits (Resolution No. 6558); and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has identified the need to adjust the fee schedule; and

WHEREAS, private fire protection charges have not been updated in two and one-half years, while water rates have increased 6.5 percent; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has always provided plan review and inspection services without charge, but has taken on increased review and inspection responsibilities from the state; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department staff are increasingly asked to conduct inspections for special events and provide services outside of normal business hours; and

WHEREAS, annual daycare/adult care licensing inspections are mandated by the state and are also time sensitive, resulting in increased workload for staff and shifting other priorities to accommodate these requests.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Albany, Oregon, authorizes the fees described in Exhibit A to be established effective July 1, 2019, for services provided by the Fire Department; and



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 6558 is hereby repealed.

Special Conditions for all Fire Protection Services - water taken under this classification is to be used only to extinguish fires and for flushing necessary to maintain fire protection equipment. In case of surreptitious or improper use of water, the consumption may be estimated, and the water used shall be billed at regular meter rates.
