

RESOLUTION NO. 6979

A RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT NOT TO EXCEED \$147,600 ON BEHALF OF CITY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR CYBERSECURITY UPGRADES, FIRE STATION ACCESS SYSTEM UPGRADES, AND PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE).

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security, through Oregon Emergency Management, makes funds available to improve community preparedness and resilience; and

WHEREAS, the need for cybersecurity upgrades to password management and secure file sharing systems has been identified; and

WHEREAS, the need for security cameras and access card readers at the three oldest fire stations has been identified; and


WHEREAS, the need for new helmets and visors for police officers has been identified; and

WHEREAS, the needs identified support the purpose of the grant, and



WHEREAS, the application deadline is April 18, 2021.
