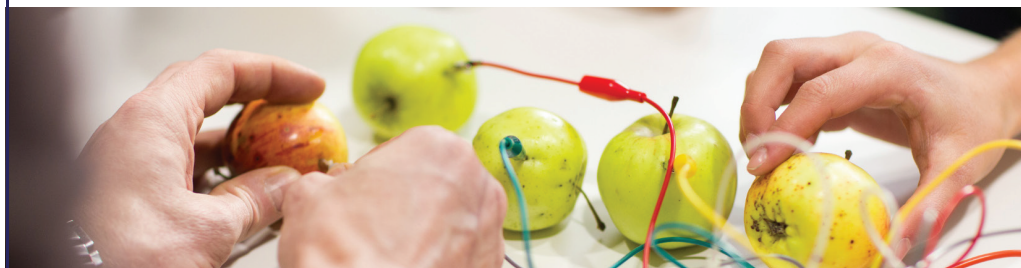

Refund Policy: Our mission is to provide quality recreational experiences that are financially sustainable. Activities, programs, and classes must meet minimum enrollments in order to be offered. If Parks & Recreation for any reason cancels an activity, program, or class a full refund will be issued.

- **Classes & Programs:** A participant can receive a full refund, less a \$5 processing fee if they notify Parks & Recreation five business days prior to the start of the class. After five days, a credit will be given. If a program is less than \$15 only a credit will be given if participant cancels.
- **Trips & Tours:** Participants will only be given refunds if a replacement participant is found, due to hard costs associated with trips.

DANCE

Families

We know movement and music are both great for our bodies and our minds – what better than combining both in a dance or tumbling class? There are opportunities for kids big and small to get moving and grooving as they build physical fitness, teamwork, and creative skills in these fun dance classes!



JUST DANCE!

A combo jazz and lyrical dance class that is fun and energetic. This dance style is often associated with Broadway musicals. Dancers will learn turns, leaps, and jumps as well as building flexibility, strength, techniques, and coordination as they move to inspiring music. Supplies: Athletic clothing, ballet slippers or socks

FAIRYTALE DANCE

There's nothing more imaginative than fairytales! Experience the magic of ballet as your child stretches, leaps, and dances across the floor. Using props and interactive songs, this class will help improve balance and coordination while introducing your child to the fundamentals of ballet. Supplies: Athletic clothing, ballet slippers or socks.

BALLET

Embark on the next level in your ballet education after Fairytale Dance! Choose between Continuing Ballet and Intermediate Ballet based on your age and skill level. Continue your development of ballet fundamentals while learning new concepts and advancing your knowledge and abilities in a diverse manner and creative environment. Supplies: Athletic clothing, ballet slippers or socks.

CREATIVE DANCE

For these classes your child will need no prior dance experience, just a willingness to move, learn, and create! We will borrow technique and form from all styles of dance and incorporate this basic dance knowledge into exercises that depend on and enhance your child's imagination. The purpose of this class is to teach your child that movement is fun, imagination can yield awesome works of art, and they're all capable of creating anything they dream of! Supplies: athletic clothing, any type of dance shoe, socks, or clean tennis shoes.



ALBANY GEMS DANCE TEAM (GRADES 3-8)

The Albany Gems Dance Team, a program offered through Albany Parks and Recreation, provides great opportunities to develop skills and the attitude youth need to be successful! Dancers learn fitness, nutrition, teamwork, and valuable life skills all while being part of a team. This team is a competitive performance team, but also has positions available for dancers that aren't quite ready to get in front of a crowd or are new to the program. Participation in the team includes practice, competitions, and fundraising. Practices are Monday and Wednesday evenings at Timber Ridge School; competition and fundraising dates vary. Payment plans are available. New participants must have approval from Coach Ashley Custis to register for the team.

8 MAGIC CAMP

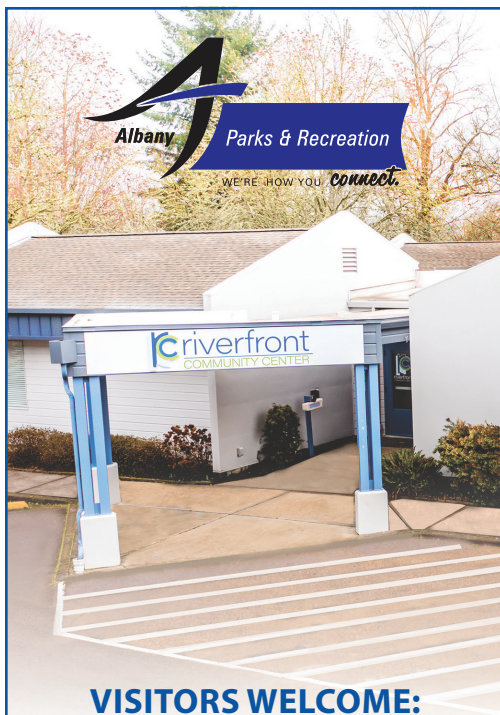

TREE CLIMBING

From a 300ft high tree, the world looks very different, like an alien planet. The perspective from some of the largest trees in the world will open your eyes to see the forest and wildlife in new powerful ways. Tree Climbing at Silver Falls State Park is the only tour operator in the United States with government-permitted access to guide participants up some of the largest and rarest trees in the world! This is a unique opportunity to experience something not even 0.001% of the population has done. Supplies: appropriate athletic clothes for the weather, water, and food.

OLD-GROWTH TREE CLIMBING

In this intro experience designed for everyone, learn to climb some of the largest and tallest trees in the world around 300ft high. Recreational tree climbing, also known as canopy climbing, is an unforgettable adventure that will allow you to climb to the top of the canopy of these massive trees where few people have been. Explore a perspective of nature rarely seen and learn about the unique ecology, plants, and animals of old-growth forests. Supplies: appropriate athletic clothes for the weather, water, and snacks.

SUNSET TREE CLIMB

Experience the beauty of a sunset from a unique perspective at the top of the canopy of giant old-growth trees! At the end of the sunset, night rappelling and climbing in the dark with headlamps is required. No experience is necessary. There will be up to 1.5 hours of hiking, along with night hiking with headlamps on the way back. Participants will learn the same basics as the day introductory tree canopy climb.

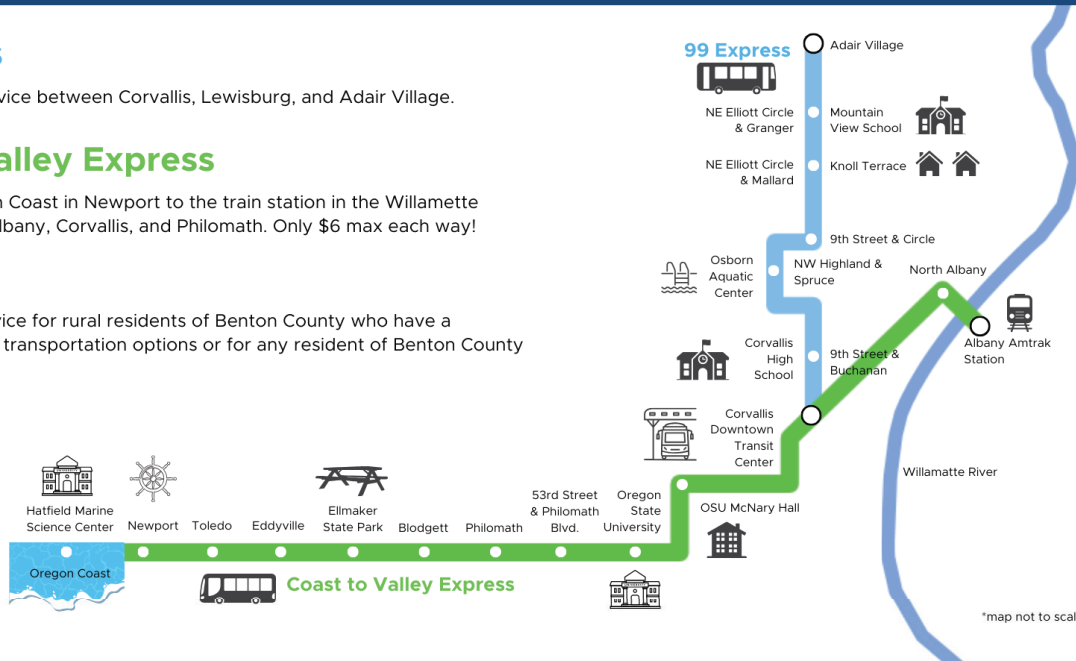

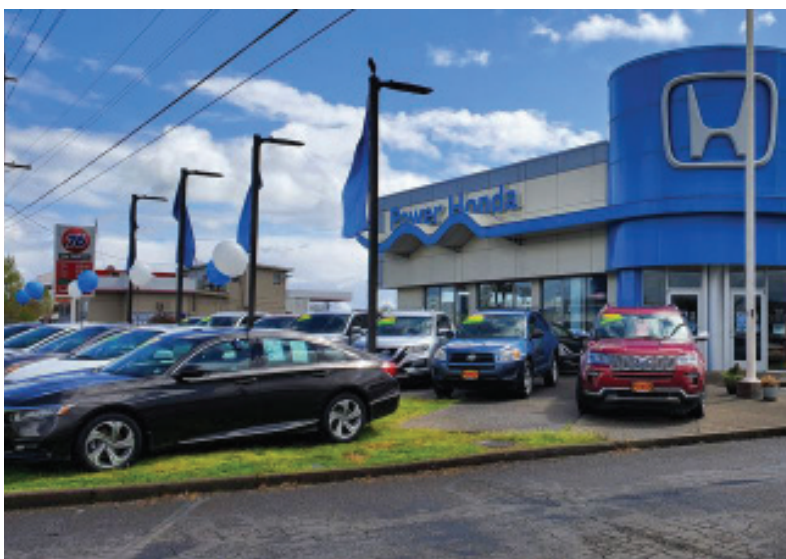

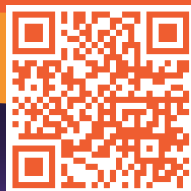
