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Scholarship Application

The Albany Police Benevolent Association is accepting applications for the 2025-2026 academic year. Applications will be accepted from Greater Albany Public Schools or Qualified Albany Home Study Seniors with two (2) scholarships being awarded.

The recipient of the scholarship will receive a \$1,000 one-time award sent directly to the college or university of choice. Applicants must be entering a two-year or four-year accredited college or accredited university program.

Criteria:

- 1. Applicant must be a senior at any GAPS school or a qualified home study senior.
- 2. Applicant must have a 3.0 or higher GPA.

Application must:

- 1. Be filled out completely, hand printed in black ink or typed and signed,
- 2. Include two letters of recommendations from non-relatives, and
- 3. A 500-word essay.

Required Essay Criteria:

- 1. Subject: "How has public safety positively impacted your life and community?"
- 2. Essay must be at least 500 words double-spaced, typed and signed with name, high school/home program, and current date in upper left-hand corner.
- 3. Include as much information as possible about your life goals and how you intend to reach them.
